Travel Options

Living in Warrnambool

If your home address is within the city of Warrnambool and you would like your child to travel to and/or from school via bus, please contact Warrnambool Bus Lines on (03) 5562 1866 or visit their website at warbus.com.au. Students travelling on these buses are required to purchase tickets which are available as either single, daily, weekly, monthly or yearly passes.

Living Outside Warrnambool

If you live outside Warrnambool, you can apply for free travel on the country bus service through its school bus program. To apply, please complete a written application form available from the College reception. Once approved, you will be contacted by the Warrnambool District Bus Coordinator to confirm you child's registration and provide you with any necessary information. If the bus line you are applying for is full, your child will be waitlisted. Please advise the College if your child no longer intends to use this Bus service. This service is not to be used for reasons other than travelling to and/or from school.

Temporary Bus Passes

Due to insurance reasons, only registered bus travellers can use the country school bus service. However, a temporary bus pass can be issued in the case of emergency or illness. A pass can be obtained from the country bus coordinator on 5560 3888. Students will be required to show this pass to the bus driver.

Conveyance Allowance Program

Families who live 4.8km or more away from King's College, may be entitled to financial allowance to help cover travel costs. You can apply for this whether your child travels by bus or private vehicle. If you have any questions regarding eligibility or application call 1800 060 970 or contact the College reception. Completed application forms should be submitted to the College reception.

Timboon Private Bus Route

The College employs a driver to transport students who live in Timboon to and/or from school on the College 39 seat private bus. This service is subsidised by the College and is available to students from Prep to Year 12. All costs are an annual fee and will be charged per student. Bus fees will be added to your school fee account and need to be paid upfront. Please contact the College for information on the fee amount.

All families are asked to complete the Private Bus Conveyance Allowance Form. The College uses Conveyance Allowance funds received from the Department of Education to reduce the cost of the Private Bus Service for families. The funds received are retained by the College to subsidise the annual cost of the Private Bus Service.
