The chosen device must meet the following specifications:

Software


The College will provide access to the required software for students, including Microsoft Office. Families will not be charged extra for this.

Backup

Students should make regular backups of their work. The College will provide unlimited cloud storage with Google Drive.

Students can choose from the following devices only:

- An Apple Laptop
- A PC Laptop
- A Chromebook
- An iPad



Device Specifications

Apple Laptop

- Solid State Drive (SSD)
- Current Version of macOS
- Minimum 6 hours battery life

PC Laptop

- Solid State Drive (SSD)
- A currently supported version of Windows
- 6 hours battery life
- Anti-Virus Software

Chromebook

- An Intel processor
- 6 hours of battery life

iPad

- Able to run on iOS 12 or later
- An external bluetooth keyboard or keyboard case.
